**Quotes to Consider**

**Godly Meditation:** "I meditate on all thy works; I muse on the work of thy hands." (Psalm 143:5) *If we do not accustom ourselves to good thoughts, we cannot be good Christians. Thinking seriously on heavenly things makes them stay in our minds, causes delight in them, and makes them nourish us. Musing on holy objects is like digesting food, which turns it into blood and spirits; so that, without holy thoughts, there is no religion. Can a man be religious and scarcely ever think of it?" -T. **Inspect the Walls:** "Do you give way to doubt in the midst of your difficulties? What about how you come to church? Do you come to church with love for God and a desire to hear His Word? What about your personal walls? Inspect those personal walls of maintaining in your life those things that must be there if you are to prosper spiritually. What about your Sabbath observance? What about the purity of your life, sexually? What about your friendships? What about your family? What about your marriage? Make an inspection. Certainly you must find that it is so easy for all of these things to fall down around us. This was the word, now, of Nehemiah after he made his inspection: "Come, and let us build up the wall of Jerusalem, that we be no more a reproach." (Nehemiah 2:17)" -C. Haak

**Pray for Light:** "...cry, cry, oh cry to God for light to see your condition by; for light in the Word of God, for therein is the righteousness of God revealed. We find sometimes the sturdy elements – integrity, justice, courage, without the beauty of grace and tenderness. Then sometimes we find the gentle qualities – sympathy, love, compassion, kindness, without the rugged virtues which are so necessary in a complete character. In both cases there is a lack. Neither strength nor beauty without the other is complete; each is but a fragment. Only when the two are united is the life really Christ-like." -J. Miller
